
Design Process From Sketch App to Abstract + Zeplin


- Sketch App: Designing

#1: Design process from Sketch App to Abstract


1. In Abstract, create a new branch from master.




2. Enter the branch name.




3. Click "Edit in sketch" button




4. Working on the sketch file.



5. Commit changed.




6. Enter the summarize changes then commit.




7. Publish and review

7.1 Make a collection that need review




7.2 Enter name of the collection and details changed


- Use title label for details changed:

7.3 Add screens that changed and need to review to the collections.




7.4 Change the status then publish.




8. Feedback.
